SUMMARY OF INMATE VISITING ELIGIBILITY BY STATUS

Inmate Status:	Comments:
Temporary Restriction Order (TRO)	No visits for first three (3) working days. Visit while on TRO only when basic visit privileges are approved by administrative review officer during three day review, or upon special visit approved by Warden. Limited to no more than one (1) two-hour basic visit during TRO process. Inmate must request visit at least seven (7) work days in advance of requested visit.
Short-Term Administrative Segregation (STAS)	No visits unless approved for basic visiting privileges by management team at the inmate's seven-day review, or upon special visit approved by the Warden. Limited to no more than four (4) hours of basic visiting during entirety of assignment to this status. Inmate must request visit at least seven (7) work days in advance of requested visit.
Disciplinary Segregation and Pre-Hearing Disciplinary Segregation (PDS or DS)	No visits while in pre-hearing disciplinary segregation, or for first thirty (30) days of disciplinary segregation. Inmates may then receive up to two (2) hours of basic visitation every thirty (30) days of disciplinary segregation dependent upon behavior. Inmates who have achieved the top tier or incentive level and have been in disciplinary segregation beyond sixty (60) consecutive days with no additional disciplinary infractions while in disciplinary segregation may receive up to four (4) hours of basic visiting in any thirty (30) day period. Inmate must request visit at least seven (7) work days in advance of requested visit. Extra time for special visits may be granted by the warden on a case-by-case basis.
Long-Term Administrative Segregation (LTAS)	Inmates on extreme isolation status may receive up to two (2) hours of basic visits in any thirty (30) day period; inmates on moderate isolation status may receive up to four (4) hours of basic visitation in any thirty (30) day period; and on a space available basis inmates on limited isolation status may receive up to sixteen (16) hours of basic visitation in any thirty (30) day period. Inmate or visitor must request visit at least seven (7) work days in advance of requested visit.
Inmates that have a Sentence of Death	Inmates classified as maximum custody as the result of a sentence of death may not receive a visit within thirty (30) days of arrival. After thirty (30) days, the inmate may receive up to sixteen (16) hours of basic visits per month. Inmate or visitor must request visit at least seven (7) work days in advance of requested visit.
Temporary Protective Custody and Protective Custody (TPC OR PC)	May visit as scheduled by facility. Schedule will allow visits at least once per week. Due to security concerns with mixing with others not on protective custody, each visit may be limited in duration or scheduled during visitation period separate from general population inmates, and may be restricted to basic visits for safety and security reasons. Advance request not required.

Inmate Status:	Comments:
Intake	Inmates assigned to intake processing are not eligible for visitation until completion of the intake process and subsequent housing unit assignment.
Boot Camp	Inmates assigned to the Boot Camp program will not be permitted visits while assigned to the first operational phase of that program, whether upon initial placement or through regression. After successful completion of the first operational phase, participants will be eligible for scheduled two (2) hour privileged visits as determined by current assignment and participation level and scheduled by WHCC. Special visits are authorized during Boot Camp graduation for graduates.
General Population	General population inmates who are not compliant with their individualized case plan and who are not actively involved in work and programming as assigned shall be entitled to no more than four (4) hours of privileged visitation each week. General population inmates who are compliant with their individualized case plan and who are actively involved in work and programming as assigned, or involved in a formalized re-entry or pre-release program, shall be entitled to up to sixteen (16) hours of privileged visits per week if so scheduled. Visiting days may be divided into separate visiting blocks and may be assigned by inmate custody, work or programming assignment, or housing designation to ensure each general population inmate is offered access to at least two (2) visiting periods per week.
Other Specialized Inmate Housing	Inmates who are housed in specialized housing not otherwise listed above (i.e., chronic mental health, infirmary, hospice/nursing care, intensive residential treatment, etc.) who are not otherwise restricted shall have access to visiting in the visiting room at the same level as general population and as scheduled.

NOTE: Except for pre-approved special visits or other extenuating circumstances, an inmate will not be released from normally scheduled education, work, or programming activities required by their individualized case plans for the purposes of attending visitation with individuals on their approved visiting list regardless of facility assignment or classification.
